## 2. A Message from your Committee

Your committee's vision is to actively seek opportunities to enhance the living style for owners/residence as well as the overall appearance of Whalers Cove. A well-maintained home will benefit its owners as well as Whalers Cove Estate. This will reward us both aesthetically and in real estate value. It makes good sense for owners to periodically check their house paint work for tell-tale signs of paint stress.

## 3. How often you need to repaint the exterior of your home depends on a few variables.

So, to answer the question:

- you should likely re-paint when the house is looking tired and dated, the paint is scuffed up or damaged beyond cleaning, or when you're sick of the existing colour scheme.
- where you live, the type of materials your house is made with, and the quality of the materials you use for the project.
- the all-important location, Coastal area homes, for instance, endure intense sun, salty sea air, and exposure to those elements means you'll probably need a lot more exterior upkeep on your home.
- Some professionals advise that you'll need to repaint the exterior of your home in as little as 5-7 years to keep it looking good others will give you 8 - 10 years before work needs to be done.


## 4. Four Tell-Tales signs when your house needs a paint job

- a. **Fading** - Most paint will fade and go chalky over time, but you will probably notice that the walls that receive the most sun fade and go chalky first. If certain sections of your walls are fading, it might be time to consider an exterior paint job to give your house a paint job.
- b. **Peeling** paint is unsightly and will often require a new paint job. One of the reasons why your exterior house paint peels could be poor quality paints from previous paint job which provides poor adhesion. Another reason is moisture, so check areas such as under your window sills where water could be accumulating. Make sure to fix any issues before you repaint your wall.
- c. **Colour changes** - While fading is usually due to natural elements like the sun, changing paint colours could indicate a larger problem. Check your home's exterior for darker or lighter patches as this could be due to water leaks that are putting strain on your paint.
- d. **Cracking paint** - Paint tends to crack around door frames, windows of a home. Check these areas for cracked paint to determine whether it's time to invest in a new coat of paint.



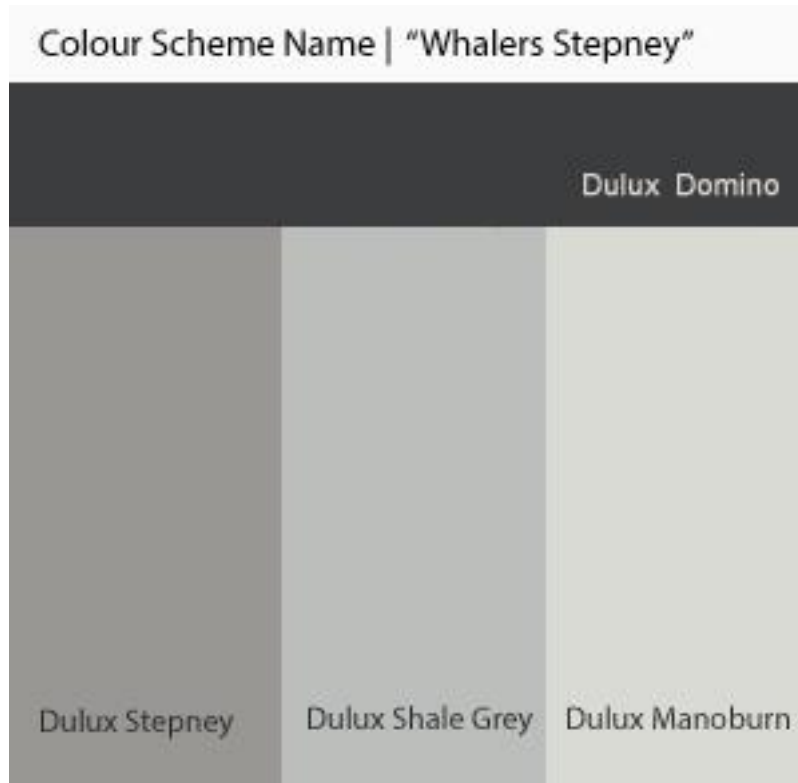

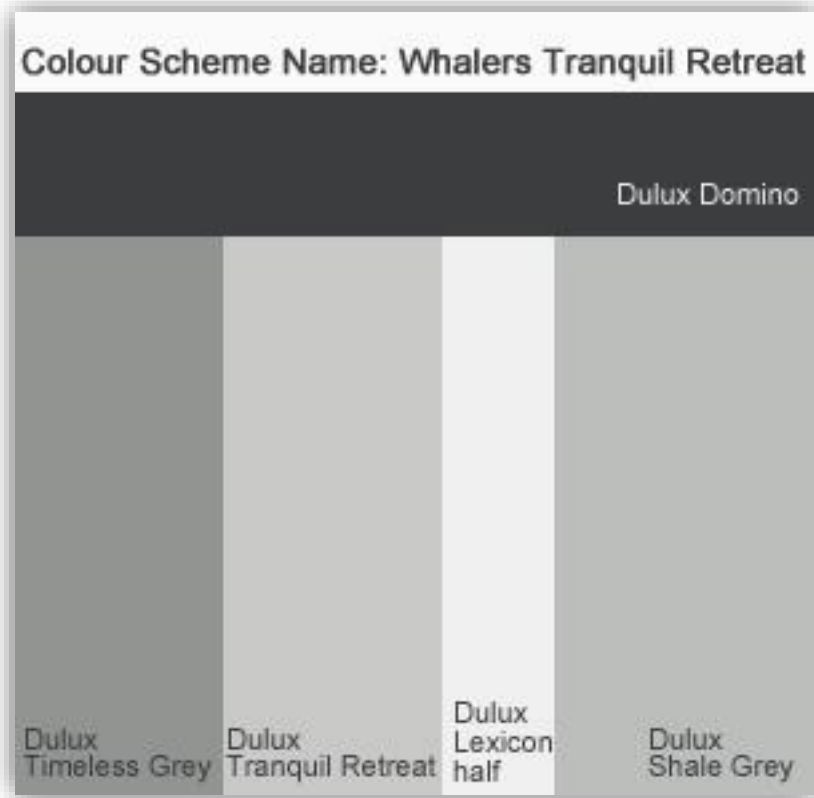
